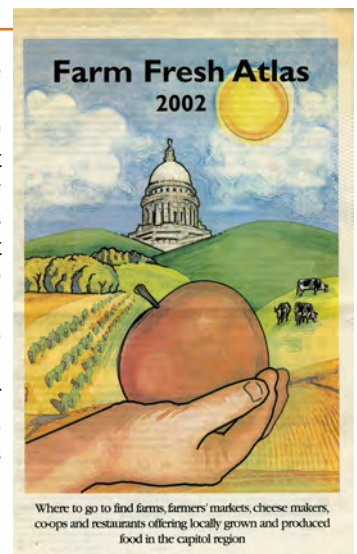
THE ATLAS PLEDGE OF COMMITMENT

To promote a sustainable food system across Wisconsin all businesses, organizations, producers, and farms pledge their commitment to:

- Operate in a way that protects and sustains natural resources.
- Provide safe and fair working conditions for employees.
- Independently manage their farm or business.
- Treat animals with care and respect, ensuring access to the outdoors.
- Support Wisconsin farmers, organizations, and local food business owners.
- Sell and promote local products, emphasizing ingredients grown or produced on Wisconsin farms.

A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE ATLAS

When the Farm Fresh Atlas launched in 2002, we couldn't lean on our mobile phones' Google Maps to help us navigate. The first Farm Fresh Atlas was a folded booklet printed on a sheet of newsprint with 50 farms, 11 businesses, and 20 farmers' markets. REAP Food Group printed out a few thousand copies of the first Farm Fresh Atlas and handed them out at the local farmers markets. Interest rapidly grew throughout the Dane County farming community, and the number of farmers listing in the Atlas quickly doubled, then doubled again. The website version at FarmFreshAtlas.org launched in 2005. In 2008, REAP Food Group printed 35,000 copies of the Atlas, adding restaurants that served locally-produced food, and expanded the territory to most of south-central Wisconsin. Interest was also growing from other regions of the state, launching other regional Atlases in Southeast, Northern, Central, and Western Wisconsin. By 2022, there were over 500 farms, farmers' markets, CSAs, restaurants, retail businesses and organizations across Wisconsin listed in five regional Farm Fresh Atlases. Last year, the regions combined in a single Farm Fresh Atlas of Wisconsin, which you will discover in these pages. We look forward to celebrating the 25th anniversary of the Farm Fresh Atlas of Wisconsin in 2026. Come along on our journey!

We are committed to efforts that strengthen food security and rebuild local supply chains, support sustainable small and mid-sized Wisconsin farms, connect rural and urban communities, and ensure that equitable power and inclusive voices shape access to good food in Dane County and statewide. We envision a vibrant and just food system where all people have access to good food, grown well.



GO THE EXTRA MILE WITH US

March 21, 2025 - Madison, WI. As we are launching the 2025 Farm Fresh Atlas of Wisconsin, our team at REAP Food Group is facing unprecedented threats to our local food system. Across the country, federal funding for agriculture, food security, and schools has been suspended and revoked, creating gaps that we are doing our best to fill. A huge blow to local food purchasing came last week when we learned that two USDA programs were being cut: the Local Foods for Schools and Child Care (LFSCC) program and the Local Food Purchasing Assistance Cooperative Agreement program. The LFSCC was set to receive \$9,000,000 to support Wisconsin schools and child care facilities to purchase food directly from farmers.

Meanwhile, food banks and other food security programs will lose significant Local Food Purchase Assistance funds that ensured locally-grown meats, dairy, eggs, vegetables and fruits were available for people who need food, and that local farmers were being paid a fair price to purchase that food. Both programs benefit our community by paying farmers a fair price for the food they produce, and to ensure families in our community have local food to eat. The cuts come at a terrible time when farmers have bought seed and supplies to grow for the programs, but now have to scramble to change their planting plans.

Our team at the Farm Fresh Atlas of Wisconsin discussed how to inform people about the importance of our work and the effects these cuts will have on our food system. Throughout the pages of this Farm Fresh Atlas, you will find stories and pictures of Wisconsin farmers and their families, restaurant owners and chefs, food entrepreneurs, and organizations that are all affected in some way by widespread changes in how our government is supporting the agriculture community.

It is more important now than ever to come together as a community, to support each other, and to buy local. We hope you use these pages to find the local producers near you who are doing incredible work to feed their communities. We hope you will shop at local businesses that buy from local farmers. If you have the means, please also donate to organizations across Wisconsin that are growing our local food system. Support Healthy School Meals 4 All WI legislation, which advocates for providing all K-12 students with no-cost school meals. Last, visit your local farmers' market and connect with the people who grow your food. When dollars stay in your community you are making our local food system grow.

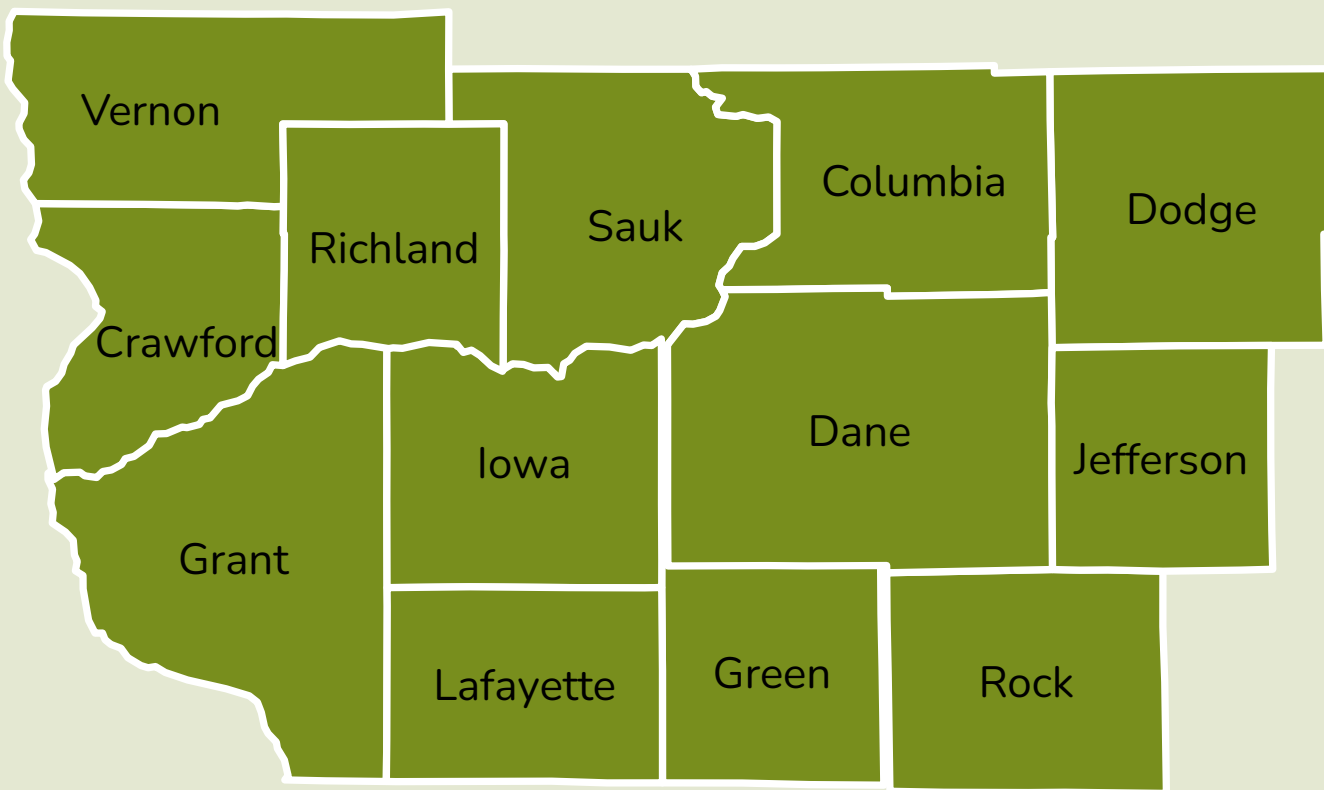

The beauty of granola is that it suits the mood anytime of day, anytime of year. This recipe—my go-to for almost a decade in restaurants, retail, and at home—is so simple that the quality of thoughtfully grown and sourced WI ingredients really gets to shine. Select firm, juicy, acidic apples for the best contrast, or substitute with hyper seasonal fruit as it appears at your farmers' market. Make more than you think you'll need, this recipe will last up to one month.

Makes about 2 qts

DIRECTIONS

Set your oven for 300F for a low, slow, even toast.

NUT/SEED MIX

Mix together nuts and/or seeds, oil and salt and toast until light golden brown—around 10 min—while preparing the rest of the recipe.

GRANOLA

In a saucepan, melt syrup ingredients until liquified; stir to emulsify. Let cool and mix flaked grains and flour in a wide bowl. Add the warm liquid to the dry ingredients and combine thoroughly. Spread out in shallow layer on a parchment-lined tray. Toast about 10 minutes at a time, tossing in between each time interval, for a total of about 30 minutes. It should be consistently golden brown. Cool and toss w/ toasted seeds.

TO SERVE

Serve with your favorite dairy or non-dairy product (even ice cream!) crushed with apple grated on cheese grater, juices and all.

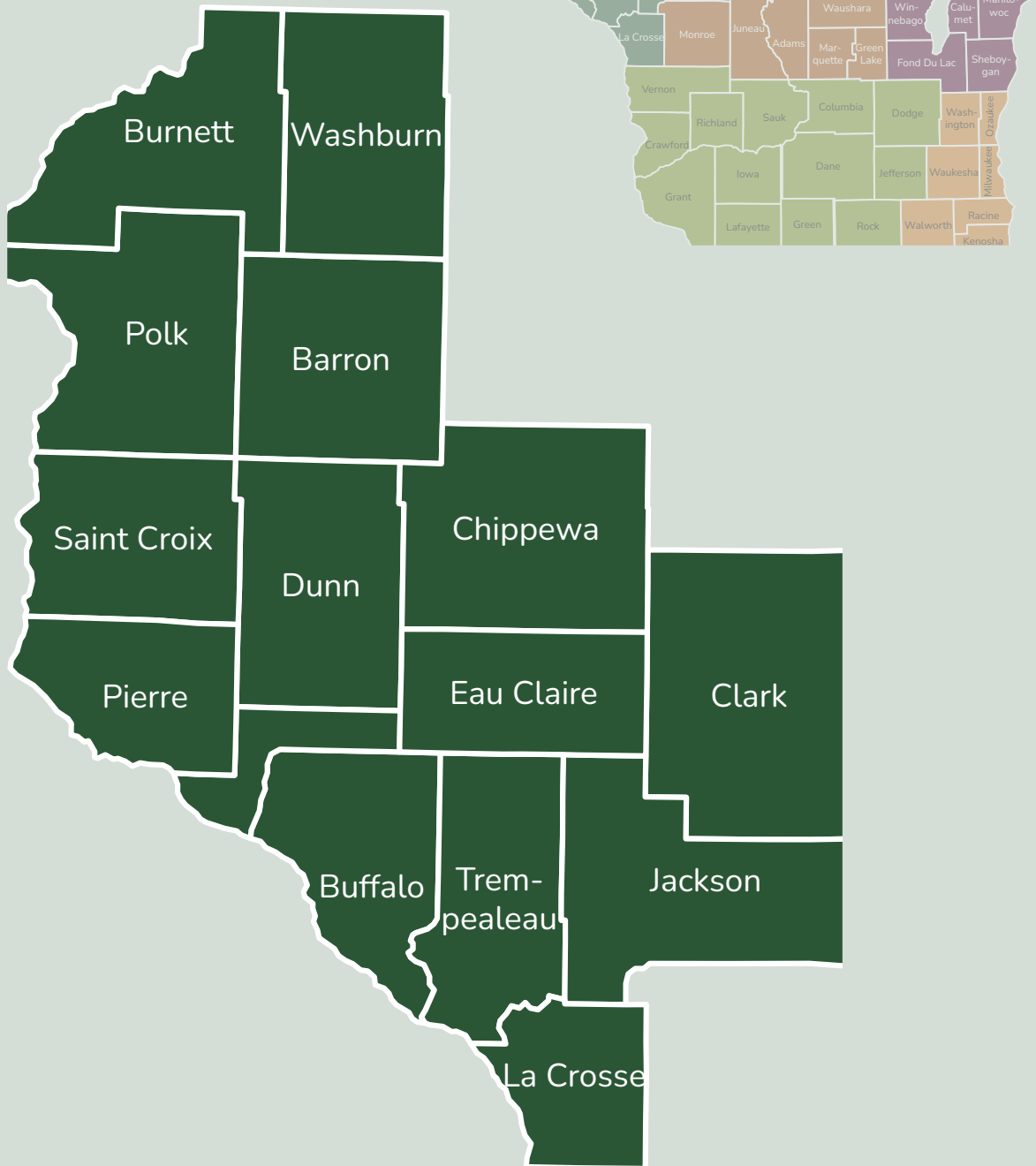

Situated on 400 acres of woods, prairies, gardens, and pine-covered bluffs overlooking the beautiful St. Croix National Scenic Riverway in Hudson, WI, The Farm at Camp St. Croix is the perfect place to enjoy a unique outdoor dining experience with family and friends.

"We started our Pizza Night and Farmers Market in 2021," explains Farm Manager Anna Zimmer. "Our goal is to bring people together, share good food and be a safe, wholesome place for the community to gather."

The Pizza Night & Farmers Market at Camp St. Croix is an interactive experience – It begins by purchasing a "starter" kit from the Farm Store including a box, homemade sauce and a variety of vegetables like green, red and yellow peppers picked fresh from The Farm. Once you've received the starter kit, you'll be guided through the process of purchasing additional ingredients from local farmers and vendors!

Eichens Cheese, a 3rd Generation Family Farm offers an assortment of artisan style cheeses made from real pasteurized cow's milk including their Parmezaan Gouda, mozzarella, and aged cheddar cheeses. Hudco To-Go, a chef-driven deli based in downtown Hudson, has a selection of local meats perfect for pizza toppings with classics like pepperoni. With an array of fresh flavors at your fingertips, you can be as basic or creative as you'd like!

Once your ingredients are collected, you're invited into a big red barn to assemble the pizza yourself (putting those ingredients exactly where they should go, or potentially should not go...) When it's ready, you bring your pizza to the wood-fired oven where the Farm Staff cook it for you! There are picnic tables in the garden to sit at,

or you can bring your own blanket and find a cozy spot to savor your freshly prepared personalized pie. You also have the option to "Take and Bake" or eat one pizza on the farm and take a second home – whatever your appetite (and tastebuds) desire!

"Remember to bring your own picnic utensils and prepare for this experience to take time, especially the baking," says Zimmer.

Guests are welcome to enjoy the gardens, take a vintage wagon ride around camp, visit with sheep, chickens, and a donkey (arriving on camp at the end of June), or enjoy family time and memories galore at sundown.

The Farm at Camp St. Croix is the first nearly year-round educational farm in St. Croix Valley, allowing kids to learn and farm outside. The natural trails and beautiful facilities make this a wonderful place for kids, teens, families, and adults to connect with nature, locally grown food, and each other.

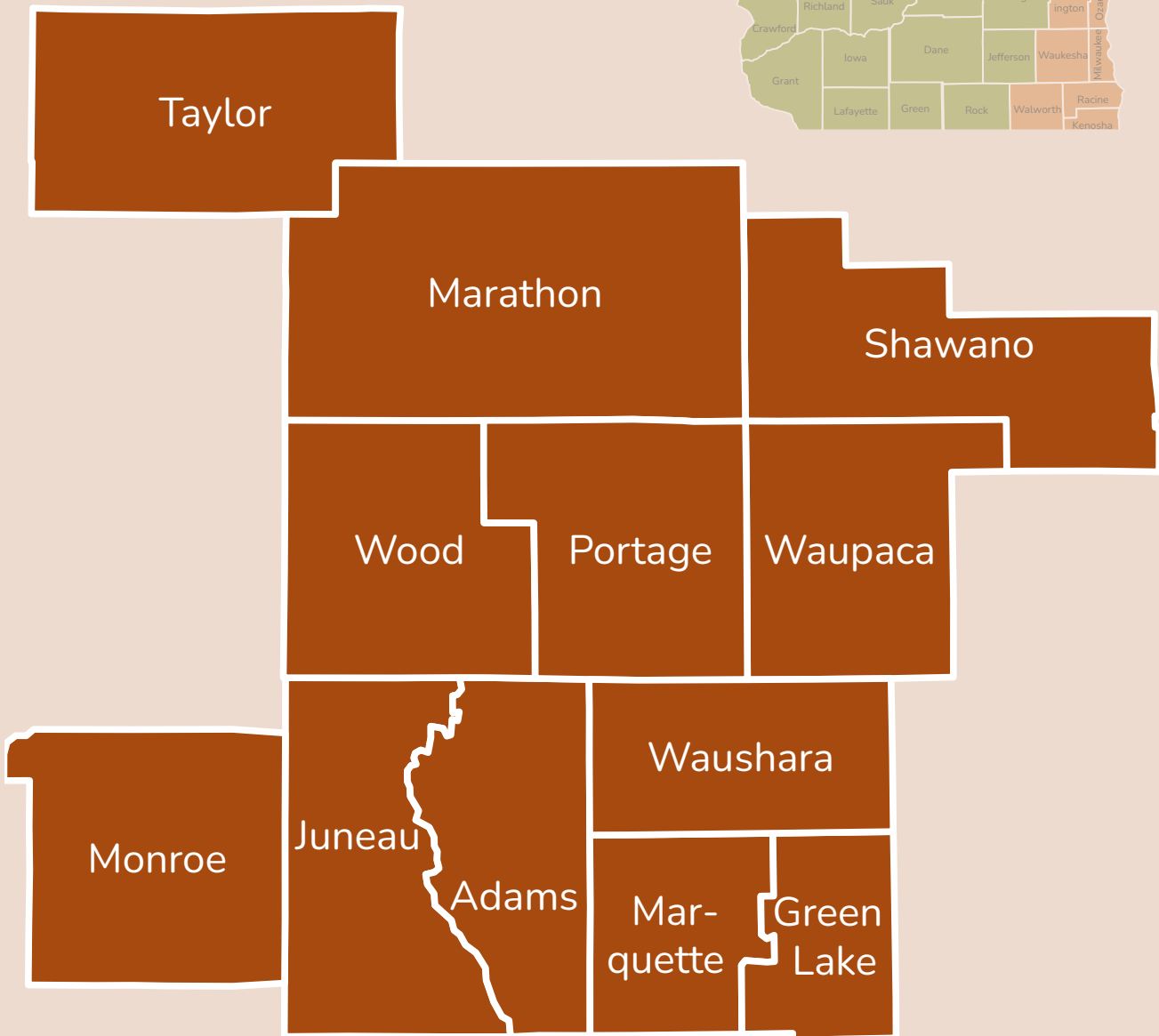

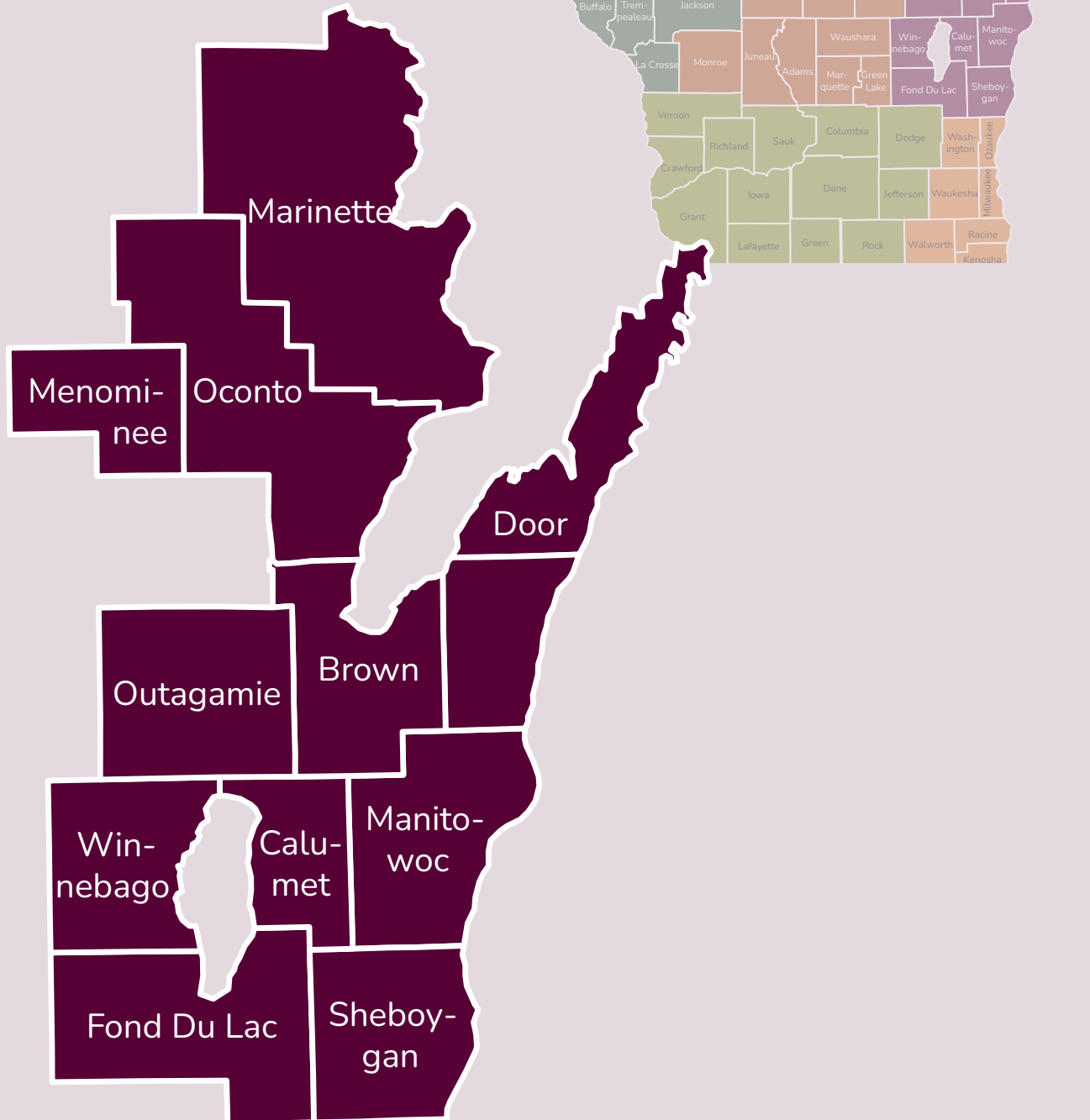

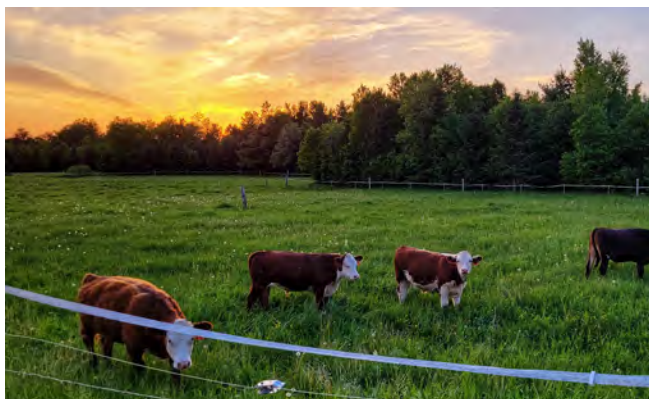

Sullivan Family Farm is a Veteran-owned farm located near Manitowoc. Ryan and Jackie Sullivan moved to the farm in 2014 from South Dakota to raise their family and grow healthy vegetables and meats for their family and community. Ryan remained in the South Dakota Air National Guard until 2021, and their farming endeavor has taken off ever since.

Their home farm encompasses 5 acres and includes 5 high tunnels and a small orchard along with 3 acres of pasture. Since 2022, they have also been renting 40 acres for grazing and market garden expansion. They raise a variety of vegetables throughout the year, using high tunnels to extend the growing season. They raise grass-fed lamb, some beef and pastured poultry. Most of their sales are direct to consumer through their on-site farm stand, but they also sell wholesale through Seasonal Harvest LLC in De Pere. The Sullivan Family was fortunate to be a part of the Wisconsin Local Food Purchase Assistance (LFPA) Program in 2023 and 2024 which allowed them to provide many of their products to Grow it Forward, a local food pantry in Manitowoc.

The Sullivans are interested in constant innovation and learning. They are incorporating larger scale vermicomposting, a deep winter greenhouse that utilizes solar to heat the rock bed for more efficient greenhouse production, using compost teas and fermentation to grow healthier, more nutritious crops, as well as using a salvaged industrial paper shredder for recycling material into bedding and mushroom beds.

EARLY SUMMER VEGETABLE SALAD WITH CREAMY GARLIC SCAPE DRESSING

Chef Selena Darrow, Founder and Executive Director of Rooted In Inc, uses fresh farm produce from Sullivan Family Farms in this seasonal Spring recipe.

DIRECTIONS

Dressing: Cut garlic scapes up into small pieces. Place in a food processor and blend until finely chopped. Add mayonnaise, milk, Parmesan cheese and lemon juice. Blend until well combined. Pour into a small bowl and season with Kosher salt and pepper. Set aside.

Salad: Using a mandolin or a sharp knife, cut beets into thin slices. Pile leaf lettuce onto a serving platter. Arrange beet slices in a single layer, overlapping slightly. Scatter with shredded carrots, blue cheese and pistachios. Season with Kosher salt and pepper; drizzle with reserved dressing before serving.

DRESSING

- 3 local garlic scapes
- ½ cup mayonnaise
- ¼ cup local 2% milk
- 3 T grated local Parmesan cheese, such as Belgioioso
- 1 teaspoon lemon juice
- Kosher salt and pepper

SALAD

- 2 medium local beets (chioggia, golden, white or red), ends removed & peeled
- 1 head local leaf lettuce, torn into large pieces
- 5 small or 2 medium local carrots, shredded
- 2 oz local blue cheese, crumbled, such as Carr Valley
- 2 tablespoons finely chopped pistachios
